

Iredell County 4-H Meat Raffle Frequently Asked Questions

Ticket Details

- How much are tickets?
 - Each ticket is \$10.
 - We're sorry, no discounts when buying multiple tickets.
- Where can I buy tickets?
 - There are 3 ways to purchase tickets:
 - Each Iredell County 4-H Club is selling tickets, so reach out to a local club member to purchase tickets and support their club
 - Stop by the Iredell County Cooperative Extension Office, Monday-Friday 8am to 5pm
 - Or, visit us during the fair (August 29-Sept. 6th, 5pm to 8pm each night) in the 2nd tent near the main entrance of the fairgrounds to purchase tickets!
- Do I need to be present to win?
 - No, the winners do not need to be present, we will call all the winners on Oct. 8th
- How many tickets can I buy?
 - Anyone can buy an unlimited amount of tickets
- How many tickets are being sold?
 - Our goal is to sell at least 1,000 tickets, but a max of 2,000 can be sold.
- How many winners will there be?
 - Each ticket has a chance at being drawn for 3 different prizes
 - (1) ½ of a hog
 - (2) ¼ of a cow
- Is the winner responsible for the processing fee of the meat?
 - No, the processing and packaging fee for each prize is included.

Prize Details

- What kinds of meats are included?
 - The ½ hog will be processed as follows
 - Will be roughly 80-90 pounds of meat and will come with an assortment of
 - Sausage
 - Pork chops
 - Ham roast
 - Picnic Shoulder
 - Ribs

- Pork Belly
 - Boston Butt steaks
- Each of the ¼ of a cow will be processed as follows
 - Each ¼ will be roughly 100-115 pounds of meat and will come with an assortment of
 - Ribs
 - Denver Steaks
 - Ribeye Steaks
 - Sirloin Steaks
 - London Broil
 - New York Strip Steaks
 - Stew Beef
 - Tip Roast
 - Brisket Quarter
 - Flank/Skirt Steak
 - Tenderloin Steaks
 - Flat Iron Steaks
 - Sirloin Tips
 - Cubed Steak
 - Shoulder Roast
 - Ground Beef
- Where is the meat coming from?
 - The ½ of a hog is coming from Naked Hog Farm from Claremont, NC
 - Both ¼ of a cow are coming from Elmore Farms from Claremont, NC
- How was the animal raised or what did they eat?
 - The hog was raised on grain
 - The cow was raised on pasture with grain everyday.
- When can I pick up my prize if I win?
 - We will try our best to have all prizes ready to be picked up on Oct. 8th, but will confirm with you the date you can pick up when we call you to inform you that you won.

 - This raffle is benefiting the overall Iredell County 4-H Program as well as each of the individual 4-H Clubs that we have in our county.
